Game of Thrones star Emilia Clarke has told how she got ticked off for not speaking a made-up language correctly.

Its creator said she "sucked" at it.

She had to learn the fictitious tongue of Dothraki as the blood and sex drama's Daenerys Targaryen.

It was spoken by her screen husband played by Jason Momoa as Khal Drogo, the leader of the vicious nomadic Dothraki tribe

The language had to be invented for the show, drawing inspiration from real languages like Russian for grammar, Swahili for nouns and Turkish/Arabic for sounds and vocabulary.

But British actress Emilia, 39, talking on the Late Night With Seth Meyers US talk show said the fact Dothraki was not spoken by anyone outside of the film set, she was criticised.

It came after she revealed she had to learn Russian for her new TV spy series Ponies as an undercover agent working in Moscow.
