The evacuation was carried out under the supervision of Russia's Ministry of Emergency Situations in the Sakhalin Region. In Kamchatka, about 60 vacationers were evacuated from Khalaktyrsky Beach with the help of three cross-country vehicles. No significant rise in water levels was recorded in nearby settlements.
