Aided by stabilizing technologies, this humanoid uses small lightweight and low cost high precision sensors developed by Toyota based upon its automotive sensor technology. It walks upright and uses it's hands to perform a variety of tasks. It is often demonstrated by playing the trumpet but the more practical function of this robot is human assistance and elderly care. Toyota Motor Corp., which has become the world's number one automaker in terms of sales celebrated its 70th anniversary on November 3, 2007. During this celebration, the motor giant announced it's long-term vision for the future, which includes robotics as one of its core businesses. ///</p>
