March 2, 2012, Tehran, Iran: Voting stations in Tehran, like the Al Javad mosque and the larger Imam Hossein mosque opened their doors at 8 am with lines being formed at more busy moments of the day. Voters have to fill in 30 names of candidates for 30 seats appointed for those voting in the capital. many tick the names of lists, which are temporary factions. but others elect their candidates individually. Iran supreme leader ayatollah Ali Khamenei said on Friday morning - after casting his vote- that he hoped for a large turnout, which would help security and stability in the Islamic republic. Voters are required to bring their ID cards, which at the end of the voting process are stamped, proving they participated in the vote.
