Oct 20, 2016 - Baikonur, Kazakhstan - Rendering of EDM Descent Parachute. ExoMars (Exobiology on Mars) is a two-part Martian astrobiology project to search for evidence of life on Mars, a joint mission of the European Space Agency (ESA) and Russian Federal Space Agency (RFSA). The first part, launched in 2016, placed an atmospheric probe into Mars orbit and released a stationary lander (which stopped transmitting shortly before reaching the surface).
