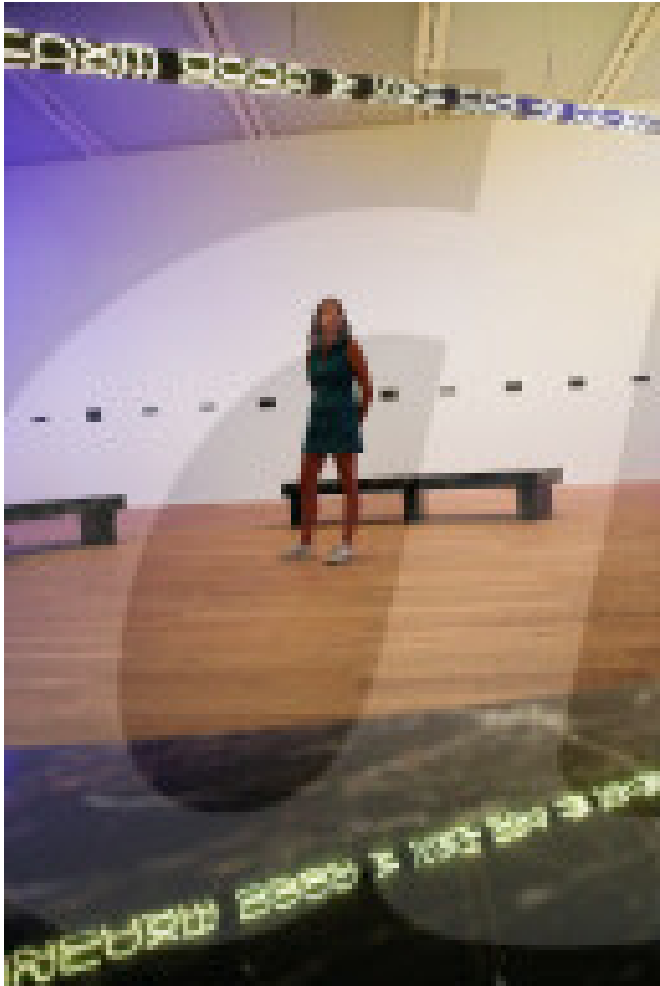


Jenny Holzer's Work At Tate Modern
